SSA Marine's operation and terminal services (on-dock) provide for complete in-gate/out-gate capabilities. Off-dock points of cargo origin stevedoring services are also provided at all local docks within the Portland/Vancouver waterfront area.

**Location:** 120 miles from the Pacific Ocean, centrally located on the Puget Sound

**Size:** 10 acres

**Cranes:** 1 100 ton Gottwald mobile harbor crane

## Driving Directions

### From North I-5

- Take Exit 195 (marked as Port of Everett on the sign)
- This exit will turn into Marine View Dr.
- Proceed left under I-5 and follow Marine View Dr. approximately 5 miles past the Everett Naval Station and the Kimberly-Clark Paper Plant
- At Everett Ave., take a right
- Everett Ave. will turn into Terminal Ave. Proceed straight to the container terminal

### From South I-5

- Take Exit 198 (marked as Port of Everett on the sign)
- This Exit will go to Highway 529
- Proceed on Highway 529 to the Exit for Marine View Dr. (which says Port of Everett)
- Follow Marine View Dr. past the Everett Naval Station and the Kimberly-Clark Paper Plant
- At Everett Ave. take a right
- Everett Ave. will turn into Terminal Ave.
- Proceed straight to the container terminal
